

How to take your fingerprints

Materials needed

1. A # 2 pencil or graphite (or Lipstick: See below)
2. Clear tape
3. Print page 2 of this document - **Make Your Mark**
4. A good quality scanner to email them (if you need to mail your prints the old fashioned way just let me know)

Taking your Fingerprints:

* **Step 1:** Use a #2 pencil (or graphite) to completely darken the box marked “Pencil Here” in the top right corner of the **Make Your Mark** page.
Be generous with the graphite. Really lay it on thick and add more as you need it.

* **Step 2:** Rub the **top section** of each finger across the graphite on the paper. The top section is the area from the tip of your finger to the first joint. Make sure you have covered the full top section with graphite.

***Step 3:** Place a piece of clear tape onto the darkened finger, covering the whole area and press gently, (placing the tape lengthwise on your finger usually works best). Be sure to capture the entire pattern.

* **Step 4:** Carefully remove the tape from the fingertip, and stick the tape in the corresponding box on the **Make Your Mark** page.

Lipstick option: If pencils just aren't your thing you can try lightly applying lipstick directly to your fingers, covering the upper section and pressed directly in the boxes indicated.

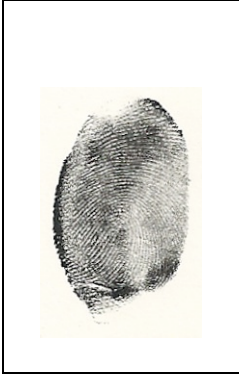
Special Note: The pinkies are often the hardest fingerprint to see so please take extra care to make sure you get the full pattern printed clearly.

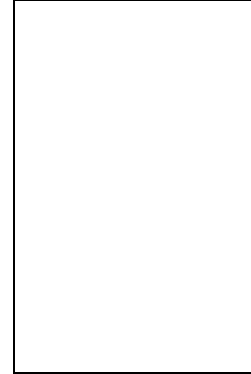
